ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION WITH REV. FR. TIPTON

OCIA / RCIA 2022-2023

PURPOSE

The purpose of catechesis in The Faith is to introduce adults to the Word Made Flesh, the Person of Jesus Christ, and if they so desire, to lead them into being his disciple. In particular, this course seeks to prepare two types of people: (1) Those who are not Christian but wish to be to receive Penance, Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist, or (2) Protestants who are already baptized to be Received into the Catholic Church, to be Confirmed, and to receive the Holy Eucharist. Either way, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist complete the Sacraments of Initiation, so this course intends to prepare adults for more full communion in the Body of Christ.

"We do not believe in formulae, but in those realities they express, which faith allows us to touch. 'The believer's act [of faith] does not terminate in the propositions, but in the realities [which they express].' All the same, we do approach these realities with the help of formulations of the faith which permit us to express the faith and to hand it on, to celebrate it in community, to assimilate and live on it more and more.

The Church, 'the pillar and Bulwark of the truth', faithfully guards 'the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.' She guards the memory of Christ's words; it is she who from generation to generation hands on the apostles' confession of faith.⁵⁷ As a mother who teaches her children to speak and so to understand and communicate, the Church our Mother teaches us the language of faith in order to introduce us to the understanding and the life of faith" (CCC, 170, 171). As adults you will be expected to grapple with faith and reason as they work in tandem to aid you in coming to know The LORD Almighty.

TEXTS

The course's arc and material derives primarily from two sources: The Catechism of the Catholic Church, and the Outline of Duties of the Christian Life as outlined in the St. Gregory's Prayer Book. These help translate the Holy Scriptures into a way of living life.

MEMORY, UNDERSTANDING, & WILL

Following Saints Augustine, Aelred, & Aquinas, we identify the Human Intellect as constitutive of Intellectual Memory (*anamnesis*), Understanding, and Will. For this reason, this course builds upon the foundation of using the Sensuous Memory (*mimnesko*) to memorize key doctrines and prayers of the Church. I.E. One must meditate upon the mysteries as the cow chews the cud. Daily memory work is expected in the home to accomplish this end, and is important for humans of all ages to come to understand Our Lord, His Church, and Her Teachings. We expect the memorization of the basics of the Christian Life. We are not checking boxes, but are giving you the building blocks upon which to build a life-long friendship with Our Lord through His Church. To enter into discipleship we must take on the Vision of Christ and the Language of his body, The Church, that we may see and act accordingly to the truth of reality. If you want to be Confirmed, you must pick a Catholic Sponsor to guide you into what it looks like to take on *Catholic Practices*, to cultivate the virtues, to be holy, to be like Christ. Follow them as they follow Christ. *It is vitally important that you learn to describe the World rightly, that you have a Catholic vision, that you may then take on the meet and right practices to live a Catholic life.* "Classes" and information are insufficient.

This course does not stop at memorization, however, nor does your work at home in regards to sacramental preparation. As you are memorizing (and certainly once you have memorized) these building blocks of The Faith, you are expected at home to cultivate an understanding of these Truths. Here, the Catechism of the Catholic Church is your guide. Monthly updates from the Catechist will include Catechism references so that you can prepare to discuss Church Teaching family, friends, fellow Catechumens & Candidates, and the catechist. This may happen during formal lessons or around the dinner table (preferably both!), as long as it is incorporated into your family life. You are now forming lifelong habits!

GUIDELINES:

Catechumens are allowed TWO absences. Beyond this, please discuss absences with the Catechist in advance if AT ALL possible. Further absences will be excused on a case-by-case basis. If a person misses a class for any reason, they must schedule a make-up class with The Catechist before the next Sunday. If a person misses more than two classes without reaching an agreement with the Catechist and the priest, the person will not be eligible to continue in this Sacramental Preparation course. If your work or family life prohibits you from coming to regularly schedule classes, please talk with Fr. Tipton about finding a day and time to meet.

Candidates will have a tailored catechetical process that will be contingent on their background and knowledge so far in the Christian life. They may be required to go through the entire OCIA schedule or just a few, it all depends on the person's background, understanding, will, and concerns. All missed classes in a situation like this will need to be made up.
